



**“ONE VOICE – ONE GOAL”  
MEETING MINUTES  
April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2009**

President Jerry Nulliner called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM. Minutes from the last meeting were distributed, motion made and carried to accept minutes with minor spelling changes. Eric Hutchinson also advised that he is the representative for Madison County Haz Mat, appointed by the IAHMR to be a representative to the “In Time” (Indiana - Traffic Incident Management Effort) committee.

Attendance roster included at the end of this report.

Treasurer’s report, Dave Wolfe advised that we have \$14,496.21 in the bank, with some accounts still outstanding. Dave further advised that several member agencies have not paid their dues for over a year, and those agencies will be notified and dropped from the roster.

Eric Hutchinson presented a “multi-lateral working agreement” from “In Time” and requested that the letter be reviewed by the IAHMR body, endorsed and returned to “In Time”. The letter was reviewed by President Nulliner, discussed with those present and signed off on by President Nulliner.

President Nulliner advised that Steve Haston, Noblesville Fire is looking for Agency pictures for the IAHMR web site.

President Nulliner advised that one of the board members has not attended a meeting in over a year. After discussion, Gary Brandt was nominated and elected, to fill the vacant position.

President Nulliner advised that the Fire Chiefs Indiana Emergency Response Conference will be held August 19-22<sup>nd</sup>. Booth space has been donated to IAHMR, next to the registration desk. At this time we need to develop a brochure for handouts, and a banner for display. Robert Crouch stated that he would look into obtaining a banner for free, or at a reduced cost. A motion was made and carried to establish a budget of \$1,000 for conference brochures and the banner.



President Nulliner distributed various handouts for the conference. Jerry also produced a memorandum of understanding for the conference, after discussion a motion to accept the MOU was made and carried.

Erick Hutchinson motioned to send a foursome to the conference golf outing, and sponsor a hole, total cost \$320, the motion was 2<sup>nd</sup>, carried.

IAHMR has a number of time slots for instructors at the conference. Larry Hamby will present OSHA concerns for Haz Mat, Tim Thomas and Mike Bigler will present 3 hours of ethanol and Meth labs. Stan Capobianco will present Haz Mat awareness for EMS, and Rex Bowser will present Radiological hazards/CST.

Mike Bigler, OSFM, advised that IAHMR needs to be involved in the formation of minimum standards for Haz Mat teams. There currently are no clear-cut standards. After discussion a “Best Practices Committee” was formed with Eric Hutchinson as chair. Committee members will be Russell Shirley, Larry Hamby, Tim Thomas, and Rex Bowser.

Mike advised that there will be a DMORT exercise at Grissom on June 6-7-8.

Mike further stated that grant monies are running out. The recent team grants came from unused 2006 grants. If any grant money is available in the future, it will be available on a very short notice, and will need to be encumbered quickly. Mike suggests that Haz Mat teams maintain a list of equipment that can be ordered on short notice. Mike reiterated that future funding would most likely be on a regional basis. Fire Act grants are more favorable to regional grants. Mary Fields from the Indiana Department of Homeland Security has information on “foundation” grants.

Meeting adjourned at 11:55 the next meeting will be July 28<sup>th</sup>, same location.
